Instructions for Using the Digital Microscope (for students)

- 1. The teacher will initially set up the microscope for viewing. DO NOT MOVE it from its location!
- 2. The digital microscope is very lightweight- use care when handling it so that you do not spill your sample or knock the microscope off. Only 1 person's hands should be on it at a time!!
- 3. The height is adjusted by turning either of the knobs on the side.
- 4. The microscope head is secured by tightening the smaller knob.
- 5. Using the pipette, place one drop of your sample onto the petri dish, then slide it under the microscope.
- 6. Turn the light on using switch on the wire that connects to the computer.
- 7. You will see the image of your sample on the computer screen- make sure you maximize the image.
- 8. Hold the microscope steady with one hand as you slowly and carefully adjust the focus by turning the silver portion with your other hand.
- 9. Never touch the lens with your fingers! The plastic guard on the end protects the lens-do not remove it!
- 10. Draw what you see on the computer screen and write down a description in your science notebook.
- 11. When your observation is complete, turn off the light, remove your specimen, and pour it out into the catch bucket. Wipe up any spills!
